# ***Eyelet Kit Instructions***

### **Your Eyelet Kit includes:**

1 punch  
1 setter  
100 eyelets (color(s) of your choice)  
Piece of cardboard or scrap paperboard (for practice)

### **You will need:**

Rubber mallet or hammer  
Hardwood plank or hard work surface  
Hat (or item of your choice) to add eyelets  
Ruler and pencil for marking your item

Prepare your workspace by laying out your materials and hat on a hard work surface. You may want to practice this exercise using a piece of cardboard or paper before working with your hat or item of choice.

1. Once you have decided where you would like to add eyelets onto your hat, mark the area of your hat where you will add the eyelet with a pencil. Be careful to position your hat so the smooth, flat side of the eyelet will face upward, finishing the look of your hat.
2. Place the eyelet punch over the marking and strike the end of the punch hard with your mallet to add the hole for the eyelet.
3. Once you have made the hole in your hat, insert the eyelet into the hole, with the cylinder side pointing upward.
4. Place the eyelet setter on top of the eyelet and strike the end of the setter hard, which will cause the cylinder of the eyelet to “flower” down, securing it to the hat.
5. Turn your hat over and inspect the area the eyelet has been applied. It may take a couple of tries to be sure that you have the eyelets in the desired position before adding a hole in your hat. Remember which side you would like the smooth side of the eyelet to be seen, as you may need to turn your hat over before adding the eyelet so its smooth side is flush with the finished side of your hat.
